In The Midst Of The Storm

Faith Under Fire

February 22, 2009

"There arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full." Mark 4:37 KJV

Dear David,

On **June 17th, 2007**, I wrote a Father's Day Commentary about my friend **Nick Robertson** in Bend, Oregon, a man of sincere faith and integrity, a loving husband, and grandfather of nine boys and girls.

Only a few days earlier **Nick had a stroke at the age of 57**, an event that changed his life and that of his wife and family forever. One of the best hardwood floor layers in Central Oregon and unable to work during a long recovery, **Nick lost his business, their income, health insurance, and home, in order to pay medical and domestic bills**. In August this past year they moved to a warmer climate with more job opportunities, having regained some control of his right hand, arm and leg, and leased a small two bedroom home. Without health insurance, an unexpected but necessary major surgery for his wife Diane left them again with thousands of dollars in medical bills for which they are unable to pay. Nick has applied for numerous jobs with no response. When prospective employers find that he has had a stroke, they are reluctant to hire him.

*"And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, **Master, carest thou not that we perish?**" Mark 4:38 KJV*

When we have done all, and know not what to do, it seems only a miracle will save us, and like his disciples, we cry out saying, *"Master, carest thou not that we perish?"*

*"And **he arose, and rebuked the wind**, and said unto the sea, peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm." Mark 4:39*

Indeed a *great storm* has arisen in America and *the waves*, while *beating* upon our *ships*, will only abate as we call upon His Name for deliverance.

Nick and Diane have not given up their faith, nor calling on His Name for wisdom, guidance, and deliverance, from the power of the *wind*. While their funds are depleted, they cry out to Him daily in the face of seemingly impossible circumstances. As Paul the Apostle raised support for the Church in Jerusalem, so **I appeal to you to prayerfully consider the needs that are now coming before us** from those our brethren in need, be they near or far, here in America or around the world.
