Oregon Republican Legislators and Leaders,

The 2020 Oregon Primary and General Election may be Oregonians last chance to stop the radicalization of state government by an entrenched and increasingly liberal ‘ruling class’ from Portland, Eugene, and the Salem bureaucracy. Their values, views, and ideology are anathema to most Oregonians.

If that is to change it must start with **regaining control of the State Legislature in 2020 by more conservative voters** – a seeming impossibility to many – but **very possible** to those with vision, facts, and the **will** to pay a price for their children’s future.

Important Facts

There are **60 House Districts** in which Oregonians choose their Representatives to the Oregon Legislature every two years.

By law, the Population of each of the 60 House Districts in Oregon is just under 64,000

Restoring Republican control of the Oregon House of Representatives **CAN** be accomplished by a *coalition* of conservative leaders with a **determined commitment, sound strategy, and the will** to carry it out in **10** House Districts currently held by democrats. After applying the **2.72% average increase** in Party registration from 2018 to 2019, the total 4 Party Registration by October 13th, 2020, (Voter Regis. Deadline) is estimated to be **2,820,674**

The estimated registration of **Republicans, Non-Affiliateds, and Independents** is **1,645,486**

Recent national polling indicates **Non-Affiliated Voters** are *opposed* to the Democrat Impeachment effort by **9%**, or **84,760** votes if applied to Oregon's registered **Non-Affiliateds**. With the extreme tax, and ideologically driven and wrong-headed legislation **supported and passed** by democrat legislators in the last two legislative sessions, it is likely to **increase significantly**, and be joined by a considerable number of disgruntled **Independents** and **Constitution** Party voters. Together with Republicans, the **50.2%** needed to win in each of nine Districts is **quite possible**.

Gaining Control of the House of Representatives

Voters in ten (10) House Districts outside of Portland and Eugene need to replace the current Democrat with a Republican to give Republicans the majority and control of the House in the next session, enabling them to set the House Agenda, and **STOP** the continued radicalization of State Government by liberal legislators in lockstep with Oregon's George Soros supported Governor.

The Oregon 2020 Project

Call a *Coalition* of business and professional associations, issue groups, and political organizations together who will focus energy, leadership, promotional support, and money, to deliver votes for Republican candidates in the **10 Oregon House Districts** whose recent elections indicate the highest possibility of electing a Republican Representative in 2020.

Identify and recruit qualified *conservatives* to run as Republicans in all 10 districts.

Identify and address specific issues of greatest concern to both **Independent** and **Non-Affiliated** voters in the 10 House Districts.

Develop a “*Contract With Oregonians*” of core issues common to all, that can be placed in the hands and before the eyes of **Non-Affiliateds, Independents, and Republicans** before the May Primary, and driven home by the November 3rd General Election; issues which Republican Candidates and elected office holders commit to address in the next session.

Develop *leadership teams* in each of the **10 Districts** to promote the **Contract to all Coalition constituencies, registered NAV’s, Independents, and Constitution Party voters.**

It is our desire to work with the Republican Party to help recruit and support strong, focused, conservative candidates for each District; and build a significant team of volunteers and leaders to fully implement a strategy to obtain the necessary **16,825** votes.

Financing The Project

It is anticipated that **\$100,000+** will be needed to communicate, promote, advance, and successfully implement this Project over the next **11** months, culminating in the November 3rd General Election.

Our 2019 Budget is \$45,982 - \$26,191 of which has been raised to date.

On “Giving Tuesday”, December 3rd, our goal is to raise \$20,000 to meet our 2019 operational budget and continue our Plan to build the **Oregon 2020 Project Coalition.**

Our End of Year Fund Drive Goal is **\$40,000** to advance the **Oregon 2020 Project** before the May Primary.
